What to bring to camp:

- ❖ 1 motivational game - Please bring a printed copy and the file on a flash drive with the rules and how to play to share! We will compile all the games on a flash drive to give to each group to take back to your team
- ❖ 1 team party idea
- ❖ Supplies for creating opposing team and spirit gift (see supplies on page 3)
- ❖ Any year team scrapbook or digital scrapbook

- ❖ Football schedule for this fall

- ❖ How often should you plan motivational activities
- ❖ Make sure to put positive spin on all activities.



Seminar #3: "Teamwork makes the Dream Work"

- ❖ Discuss the importance of keeping a scrapbook
 - Who's responsible for taking pictures?
 - How will you divide and categorize you book?
 - Will your book have a theme? Your year have a theme?
 - Will you allow team members to contribute to the book?
 - When do you want it to be completed by?
- ❖ Opposing team gifts
 - Discuss the importance of sportsmanship amongst your team
 - Does you district have any rules against bringing a team gift to exchange?
- ❖ Discuss a budget for each week's gifts.
- ❖ Team spirit gifts
 - How often should you exchange gifts?
 - If you have big/lil sisters, how often do you exchange? Is there a price limit? Do you plan ahead or give themes for gift ideas?
 - Candy grams - cheap, motivational gift for football games
- ❖ Community Service Projects
 - Unique ways you can 'give back' to your community
 - Make donations for a cause in lieu of opposing team gifts
 - Awareness performance at pep rally (Kick for Kindness, etc)

Seminar 4: "Finish Strong"

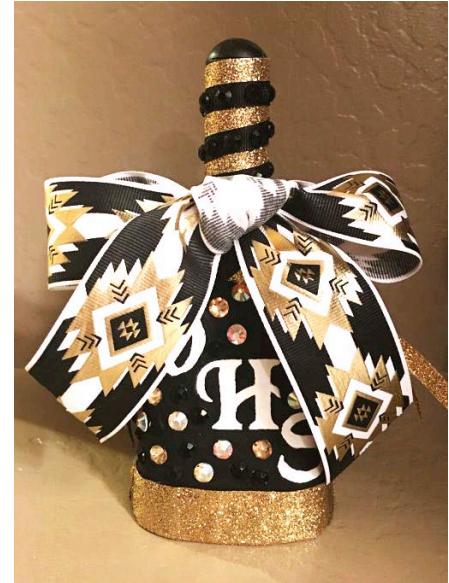
- ❖ Goals for the year

Supplies needed for Spirit Gifts

#1 - Cowbell Gift

- Cowbell for each social officer
- Paint for exterior of cowbell
 - School colors
 - FUN Colors
 - ANY COLOR!!
- Decorative items
 - Rhinestones
 - Stickers
 - Letters for name
 - Puff paint (solid, glitter, etc)
 - Duck tape (solids, glitter, patterns)
- Ribbon to match
 - Different widths
 - Sparkle, solid, fun prints
- Extras
 - Paint brushes
 - Hot glue
 - Rhinestone glue



#2 - Spirit Stick gift

- Dowel Rod 36" (width can vary)
- 3 School Letters (ex. BHS or REL)
- Paint for letters and rod
 - School colors
- Decorative items
 - Marabou fur
 - Feather Boa
 - Glitter
 - Rhinestones
 - Duck tape (solids, glitter, patterns)
- Ribbon in school colors
 - Grosgrain or silky
 - Patterns and solids
 - Skinny and wide variety
- Heavy duty glue
 - Hot glue
 - Gorilla glue
 - Rhinestone glue
